BOARD ELECTIONS

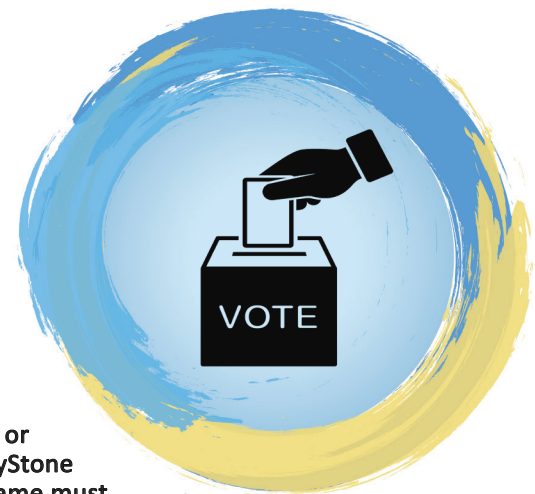
Three board of directors seats are up for election in 2022. Eligible members may become a candidate by being selected by the GreyStone Nominating Committee, or by nomination by petition of members. For consideration by the Nominating Committee, complete the application and Candidate Affidavit at greystonepower.com. The deadline to complete and return the forms is Friday, April 15.

Directors seeking re-election this year are David Hagenow in District 3 (Douglas and Paulding counties); Billy Mayhew in District 5 (Carroll and Douglas counties); and Lucy Andres in District 9 (Cobb County).

For those seeking to be nominated by petition, 50 or more signatures from GreyStone members of record (the name must appear on the electric bill) and a Candidate Affidavit must be submitted by Thursday, June 30. A petition form and the Candidate Affidavit can be found at greystonepower.com.

All nominees must live within the geographic boundary of the district they seek to represent, are subject to a criminal background check and must meet all other conditions of eligibility set forth in the Bylaws.

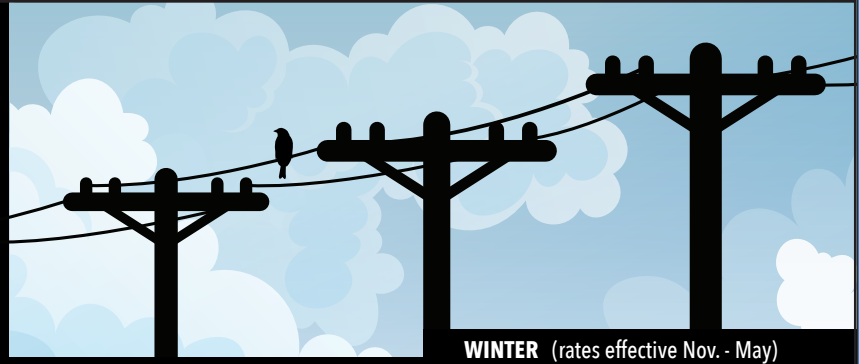
