LINEMAN APPRECIATION MONTH

Electric membership corporations (EMCs) across the country, including GreyStone Power, will join together in April to support electric utility linemen whose expertise and knowledge are vital each day, but especially critical when outages occur and power restoration is required.

Not everyone is willing to answer the call to spend days away from home, juggle unpredictable

work schedules or work long hours in the rain, sleet and snow. On top of that, the dangers inherent in working with electricity are often compounded by extreme weather conditions and dangerous terrain in remote areas, ranging from North Georgia mountains to South Georgia rivers, streams

However, over time, electric utilities in Georgia designated April as Lineman Appreciation Month so that electric cooperatives and other utilities could celebrate across the state in their respective communities at a date and place suitable for each utility.

Gov. Nathan Deal issued a proclamation last year observing April as Lineman Appreciation Month in Georgia, after the State House and Senate passed two companion resolutions.
