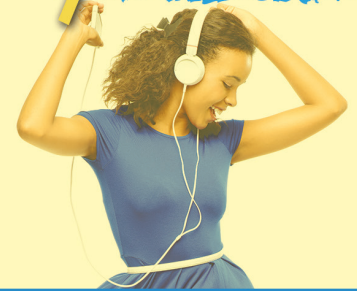

POWERING ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

GreyStone Power is focused on making life better. One way we do that is by supporting economic development in the communities we serve. With more than 3,400 commercial members, your co-op is focused on retaining existing jobs and attracting new ones in our eight-county service area.

Recently, multiple new businesses have been announced in our service territory.

Stitch Fix Inc. bills itself as an online styling service. This project began with a planned 925,800-square-foot facility constructed by DCT Industrial Trust. Stitch Fix will eventually create 900 jobs in Douglas County when they are at full capacity, with 50 jobs as they start up.

Also, Crown Linen in Fairburn occupies a 154,000-square-foot facility. Crown Linen is expected to bring 120 new jobs.

Other new commercial clients and job growth include Preferred Freezer with 73 jobs, Atlanta Bonded Warehouse with 40 jobs and Wood Spring Suites with 18 jobs.

"GreyStone is proud to have the opportunity to serve these businesses and help promote economic growth," says Gary Miller, president/CEO of GreyStone.

Outside of providing electricity to commercial members, GreyStone nurtures the economy through the work of its employees. Miller is a member of the Development Authority of Douglas County. GreyStone Vice Presidents Kara Pearson and James Wright both serve as immediate past chairs for the chambers of commerce in Douglas and Paulding counties, respectively.
