Board Nominees Selected

The GreyStone Power Nominating Committee met May 4. Board incumbents John Walton, District 2, Paulding County; Maribeth Wansley, District 6, Fulton, Fayette, Coweta Counties; and Milton Jones, District 7, Fulton County, were all nominated for another term in office.

The nominees will be on the ballot for board elections, which will be conducted by mail in late August/early September. The results will be announced Saturday, Oct. 14 at GreyStone's Annual Meeting of Members at the Douglasville office.

An eligible member may also be nominated by submitting a petition signed by 50 or more GreyStone members of record (the name must appear on the electric bill). To run by petition, members must complete the petition form and candidate affidavit found at greystonepower.com. The deadline to submit the completed petition and required affidavit is Thursday, July 6.

Candidates desiring to have their name and biographical information included in the Annual Meeting ballot edition must submit information in the format and manner required by the Credentials and Elections Committee by Wednesday, July 12.
