

Process for Interconnection

- ✓ **Homeowner/Business** must **complete** and **sign** the online Residential Application found on our website at <https://greystonepower.formtracking.com/forms/wss/form67.html>. Once the residential application is received, the **Distributed Generation Interconnection Agreement*** will be mailed to the homeowner/business. An email will be sent to the solar contractor advising receipt of the application from the homeowner. Also, a request is sent to the contractor to complete their portion of the application. A representative from our engineering department will advise the member/customer if the application meets all GreyStone Power Corporation's specifications and practices.
- ✓ Contractor will receive a link where they can upload site plans, one-line diagram, the specifications of the inverter and panels, and if applicable, back-up battery information. Once the information received meets approval, the solar contractor will be contacted and informed that installation may begin.
- ✓ Upon completion of the installation, **email** the final, signed jurisdictional approval (electrical permit) for the member's/homeowner's or business owner's generating facility from the local government entity to lisa.lonon@greystonepower.com. (No screenshots of passed permits accepted.)

***All Distributed Interconnection Agreements must be signed by the homeowner/member in their original signatures, no docu-signed or any other forms of copies will be accepted.**
