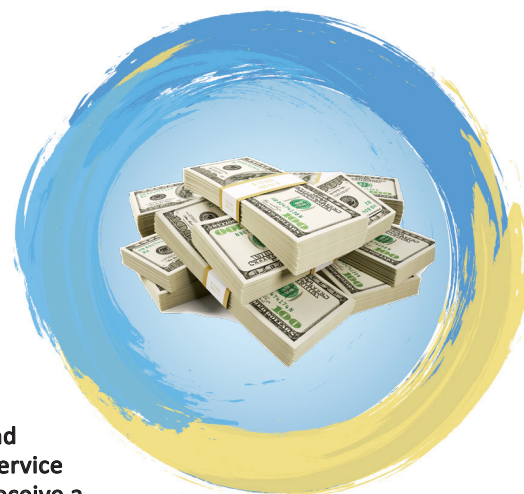

## \$12 MILLION BACK TO MEMBERS

Shopping trips cost more than what they used to, and with costs rising by the day, it can be hard to keep up with the changing times. That's why GreyStone Power works diligently so we can return a portion of the prior years' margins above the cost of doing business to members. This year, GreyStone has some really good news: \$12 million back to the people it serves!

Capital credits are given to members who received power from GreyStone in specific years, and the amount is determined by the portions of your energy use. Checks are mailed every fall, around Oct. 1, and they represent a portion of the margins from the most recent year as well as the oldest previous years. Members and former members who had service in 2003, 2004 or 2022 will receive a capital credits check this year.



Why does GreyStone do this? Our philosophy is simple. As a not-for-profit electric cooperative, we are owned by our members. Instead of giving money to nonmember shareholders, we return it to those who own and use GreyStone Power. GreyStone has returned \$182.2 million in capital credits to members since 1936.

How is GreyStone able to do this? At GreyStone, we are focused on keeping rates low while providing our members with safe and reliable power. GreyStone is almost 25% cheaper than Georgia Power for members using an average of 1,500 kilowatt-hours per month, according to the Summer 2023 Residential Rate Survey from the Georgia Public Service Commission, which can be found at [psc.ga.gov](http://psc.ga.gov).
