At GreyStone, we dedicate this day to honoring the skill and commitment our linemen bring to their jobs daily.

Linemen play a crucial role, especially during outages when power restoration is needed. In the event of widespread outages, GreyStone and neighboring electric co-ops can deploy additional crews to assist. In times of extreme weather, seeing a bucket truck driving down the road can be a reassuring sign of hope.

"I have a ton of respect for those guys and what they do," says Operations Manager Jarred Stevens of GreyStone's linemen. Stevens worked his way up through GreyStone's apprentice program to become a lineman and served as the co-op's director of safety and training before taking on his current role. Members can help ensure linemen's safety by staying alert near roadside work areas. Georgia's Move Over Law requires motorists to shift to an adjacent lane when approaching a stationary utility or emergency vehicle with flashing lights. If moving over isn't possible, drivers must slow down. Many emergency and utility vehicles have been struck while parked on Georgia highways, even with lights activated.
