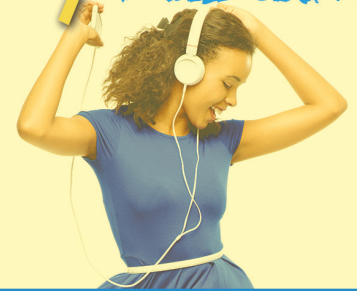

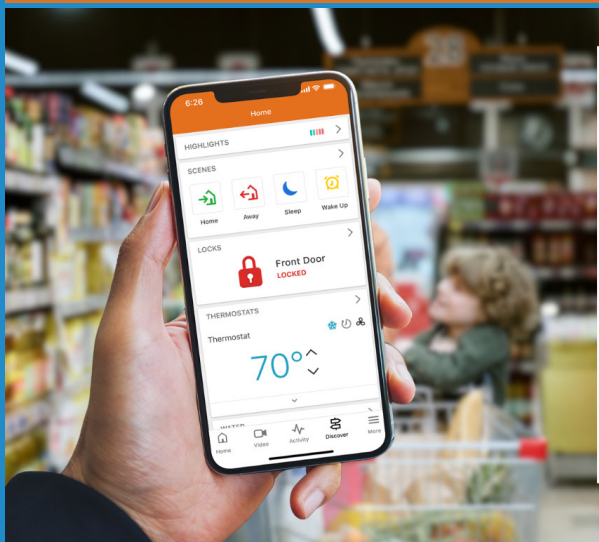

Members can support linemen's safety by remaining vigilant in roadside work zones. Georgia's Move Over Law requires drivers to move into an adjacent lane when approaching a stationary utility or emergency vehicle with flashing lights. If changing lanes is not possible, motorists must slow down. Despite active warning lights, many utility and emergency vehicles have been struck while stopped on Georgia highways.
