Members once again enjoyed a return of revenues. This year, \$12 million in capital credits was

given back to current and former members. While other companies are focused on increasing profits, your not-for-profit electric cooperative is dedicated to giving back as much as we can.

Also, you paid a lower price for power compared to other electric utility consumers. GreyStone has the lowest rates in the state at 1,000 kilowatt hours, according to the Georgia Public

Service Commission's 2022 winter rate survey. Learn more at psc.ga.gov.

Employees at the co-op work tirelessly to look for ways to improve consumer satisfaction. One large project completed this year was our outage text alert system. Members now can enjoy the convenience of receiving text messages in the off chance a power outage occurs. These alerts will also let you know when power is restored.

Additionally, GreyStone is launching a pilot project to provide access to high-speed internet to over 5,000 unserved and underserved locations within our service area.

The pilot project's proposed route is expected to provide broadband access to members in areas of southern Fulton County, southern Douglas County, portions of eastern Carroll County and a small section of southern Paulding County.

This year has been a monumental one, and you can always rest assured that GreyStone is focused on making life better.
