
GIVING TUESDAY

It is November, which means that Giving Tuesday is right around the corner. Each year on the Tuesday following Thanksgiving, millions of Americans donate billions of dollars to U.S. nonprofits.

As a GreyStone member, you have the opportunity to help give back every month by simply rounding up your power bill to the nearest dollar.

On average, members give \$6 a year. When you combine all of the members who participate in the program, the impact is great to the community GreyStone serves.

Through our Operation Round Up program, more than 28,000 of our members voluntarily round up to help their neighbors.



During the 12 months ending in August of this year, we have funded \$20,000 in scholarships and more than \$532,000 in assistance for groups like Sweetwater Mission, Kids Peace, SHARE House, Special Olympics, Warehouse of Hope, the Good Samaritan Center, Atlanta City Baptist Rescue Mission, CASA of Paulding and Douglas counties, Truth in Nature and more.

Since the program's inception in 1998, GreyStone members have given more than \$6 million to support the program. "I applaud each one of our Operation Round Up participants for the generosity they've shown their neighbors," says GreyStone Board Secretary-Treasurer David Hagenow.
