GreyStone Power Foundation, Inc. / Operation Round Up Scholarship Fund Criteria

- 1. The recipient's primary residence must be the household of a GreyStone Power member.
- 2. The recipient must be enrolled in an accredited program, either full-time or part-time.
- 3. The recipient may be an undergraduate or graduate student.
- 4. The scholarship fund will be in the form of a grant program with funds being paid to the college or university.
- 5. A person may submit an application each year, but previous winners are not eligible for a second scholarship.
- 6. The scholarship fund will provide for each scholarship winner's educational expenses.
- 7. The school shall return any unused funds to the scholarship fund.
- 8. The scholarship may be used at any two-year or four-year accredited college or university.
- 9. A combination of need and academic ability will be used in determining scholarship fund winners.
- 10. The GreyStone Power Foundation, Inc. will administer the scholarship fund.
- 11. Applications will be considered and winners selected by members of the GreyStone Power Foundation, Inc. Board of Directors, which disburses Operation Round Up funds contributed by GreyStone Power members.
- 12. GreyStone Power employees and employees' family members are not eligible to apply.
